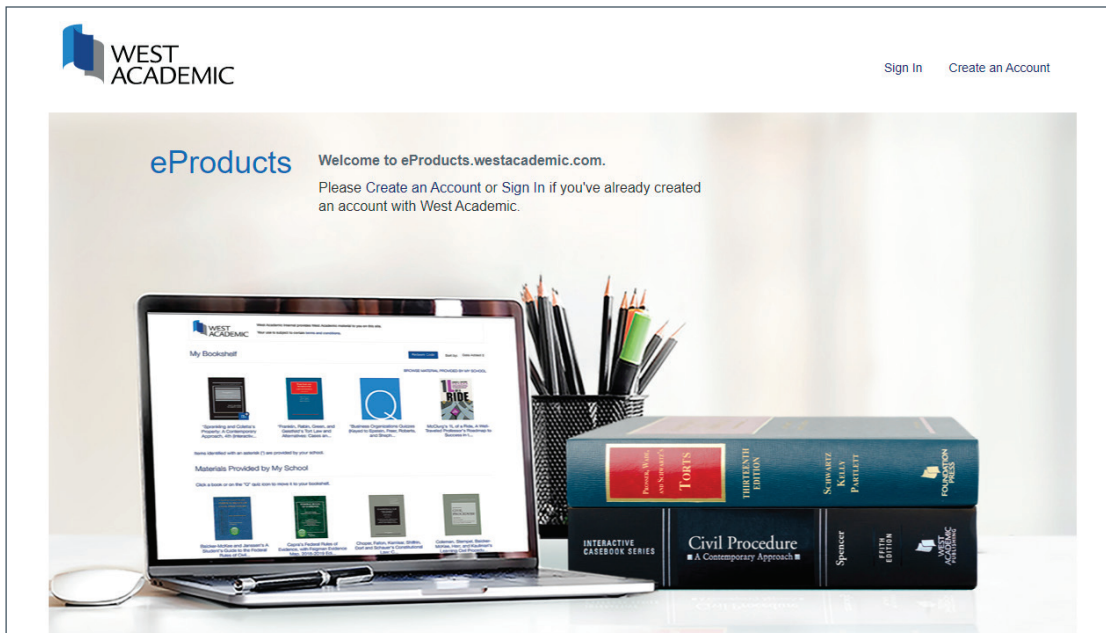
INSTRUCTIONS

You have temporary eBook access to all West Academic and Foundation Press® books adopted at your school for this coming semester. Your free trial access begins the week before classes start and lasts through the first two weeks of the semester. Follow the instructions below to set up early eBook access and learn how to purchase a discounted eBook for access beyond that period.

How to start your free trial:


Go to eproducts.westacademic.com and Create an Account or Sign In if you've already created an account with West Academic. Be sure to **use your law school email address** when creating an account.



If you created a new account, you will receive a verification link in the inbox of the email address you used to sign up. Before you get started, you'll need to verify your account by clicking the link in the email you've received.

Once you are logged into eproducts.westacademic.com, look for the available eBooks below “Materials Provided by My School.” Click on your assigned casebook to add the book to your bookshelf and start the free trial. You can add multiple casebooks to your bookshelf.

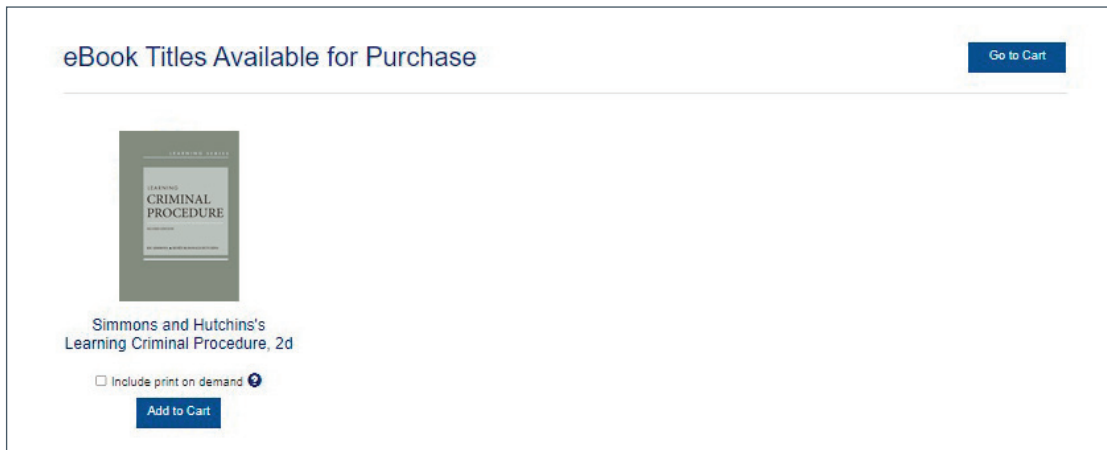

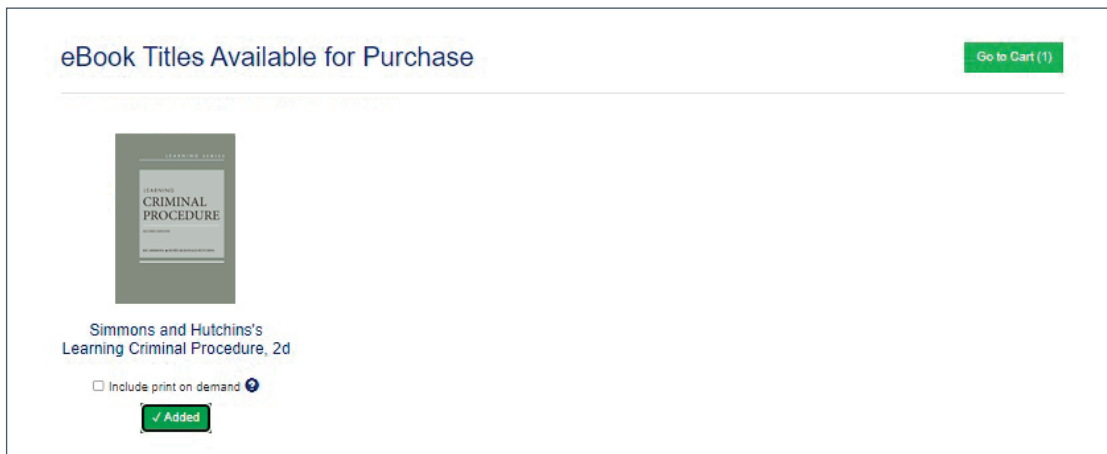
